## POSTDOC POSITION (F/M/X)

focused on the history and/or philosophy of scholastic traditions in Tibetan Buddhism, starting **November 1**st, **2025** or soon after this date.

Until 30.06.2026, the position is part of the ERC-funded consolidator project TibSchol - "The Dawn of Tibetan Buddhist Scholasticism (11th–13thc.)" (H2020-CoG-101001002). A continuing position will be awarded on a fixed-term basis for 3 years following an interim assessment.

## Your tasks:

- Conduct independent research on the scholastic traditions of Tibetan Buddhism based on original language sources in Tibetan. The focus should be in the area of scholastic networks and/or specific tools and themes in scholastic literature. Consideration of the formative phase of Tibetan scholasticism is required in the first phase of employment (until 30.06.2026).
- Participate in data management of TibSchol prosopographical database and digital library
- Publish at the highest scientific level and present research findings at academic events
- Participate in the institute's activities by (co-)organizing academic events

## Your profile:

- Completed doctoral degree or PhD in Buddhist Studies or Tibetan Studies
- Excellent knowledge of Classical Tibetan; knowledge of Sanskrit is an advantage
- Experience, demonstrated in publications and/or PhD thesis, in historical research involving Tibetan sources and/or philosophically oriented research based on Tibetan sources in original language; experience with sources in cursive script an advantage.
- Deep familiarity with the early Tibetan religious and scholarly context and the dynamics of intellectual exchanges. Familiarity with the relevant textual corpus as well as research in the field
- Skills in the use of digital humanities tools and high computer literacy (experience with TEI/XML a plus)
- Capacity to carry out research independently and as part of a team
- Excellent command of English (written and spoken) and strong inter-personal skills

The annual gross salary according to the collective agreement of the Austrian Academy of Sciences (OeAW) is € 69.028,40 (before taxes). Funds for conference and travel are available within the limits of the institute's budget.
