As part of the Institute for Habsburg and Balkan Studies (IHB)'s mission to become a global center of Habsburg-Ottoman Studies, we are pleased to announce the fourth installment of the Intensive Summer School on Comparative Habsburg-Ottoman Paleography. This two-week intensive program is dedicated to the comparative study of early modern (1500–1800) Habsburg and Ottoman primary sources.

Held at the centrally located Austrian Academy of Sciences in the 1st District of Vienna, the program features morning and afternoon lectures taught by experienced scholars. Additionally, participants will engage in guided visits to Austrian archives (HHStA, ÖNB), selected museums, and a historical tour of Vienna, highlighting sites directly and indirectly linked to Ottoman-Habsburg history. The 2026 edition will feature a full-day class at the premises of the Haus-, Hof- und Staatsarchiv.
