THE EXEDRA-FOUNTAIN ON THE ARCADIAN STREET AT EPHEOS

NEW DATA FOR A PRELIMINARY GRAPHIC RECONSTRUCTION

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Unearthed in the year 1899 along with the ending stretch of the Arcadian Street, the monumental exedra located in front of the entrance to the Harbour Baths, with its diameter of over 10 m, is one of the main late antique fountains in Ephesos. Despite its dimensions, it is a largely unpublished building, perhaps due to the fact that almost nothing of its decorative elements have been found. The survey and the analysis of the structures carried out in September 2019 allowed to collect a large number of data fundamental to the creation of a preliminary reconstruction of the fountain's elevations and of its transformation over time.
