A holistic approach has been developed in recent decades. Its goal is to reconstruct, as far as possible, the entire "life cycle" of a book (involving changes in its original structure, changes of ownership and changes of use), the contexts and dynamics of its production and circulation, the general manufacturing principles and the peculiarities of the different book cultures.
