Marjorie Burghart is a permanent research fellow at the French Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS), and is based in the CIHAM UMR 5648 research centre on Medieval Studies in Lyon, France. She is the head of a cross-disciplinary [Digital Humanities program](#) at the CIHAM UMR 5648, a large research centre on Medieval Studies. In this position, she coordinates the computing aspects of several projects involving the electronic editing of medieval documents in TEI format (for instance [Sermones.net](#) with the structural and thematic analysis of latin sermons, or the Interactive Album of Mediaeval Palaeography offering TEI-encoded paleography exercises). She is also the creator of the [TEI Critical Apparatus Toolbox](#).

The workshop will focus on specific questions and problems the participants may have. Participants are encouraged to bring their own work or editions in progress. To make the workshop efficient, it is required for participants to go through the free online course on XML/TEI before the workshop: *Digital Scholarly Editions: Manuscripts, Texts and TEI Encoding* (<https://teach.dariah.eu/course/view.php?id=32>).<sup>1</sup> The online course offers a general introduction into encoding medieval manuscripts into XML/TEI, including necessary software and most common cases.
