## „1683. A New History“

Dienstag, 12. November 2019, 15.00 s.t. – 17.00 Uhr

Universität Wien, Hauptgebäude, Marietta-Blau-Saal, Universitätsring 1, 1010 Wien

The second Ottoman siege of Vienna in 1683 has represented to generations of scholars and especially European public an archetypical religious battle between Christian Europe and the Islamic world. However, the “year of the Turk” was a product of long-term institutional and geopolitical peculiarities in Vienna and Istanbul as well as short-term conjunctures. This new narrative compares the Ottoman grand vizierate with European chief ministry in the seventeenth century while also analyzing Kara Mustafa Paşa’s grand vizierate (1676-83) within the history of pre-Ottoman and Ottoman-era vizierate. The presentation will also highlight the role of the plague that broke out in Central Europe and the Ottoman Empire in the late 1670s which substantially influenced the coming of the siege by handicapping Austrian diplomatic efforts in Istanbul, a hitherto neglected element in studies on 1683.

**Yasir Yilmaz** (keynote speaker) holds a M.A degree in Ottoman history from Bilkent University (Ankara, Turkey) and a Ph.D. from Purdue University (West Lafayette, Indiana, USA) in Habsburg and Ottoman history. He is currently Assistant professor at Palacký University in Olomouc (Czech Republic) and visiting lecturer at the University of Innsbruck.
