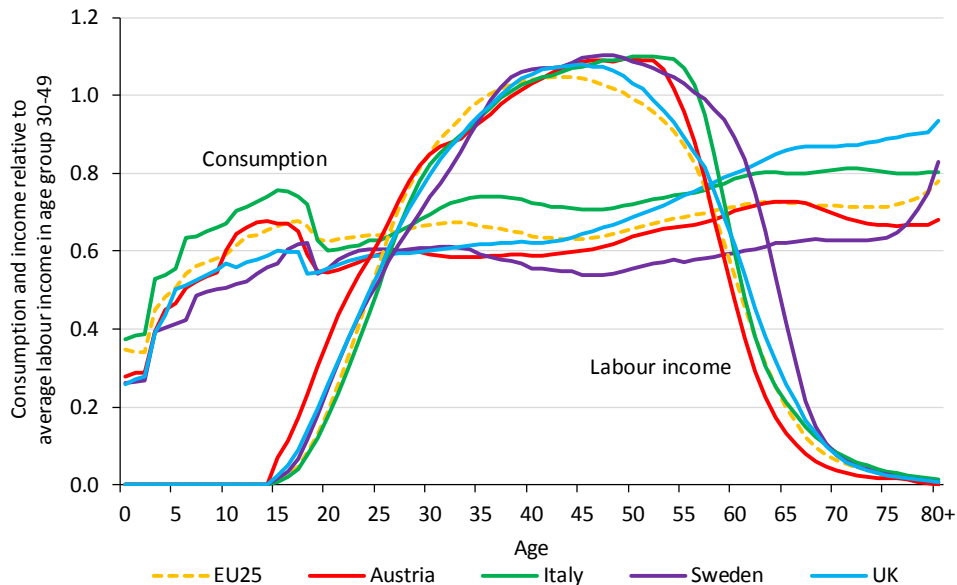

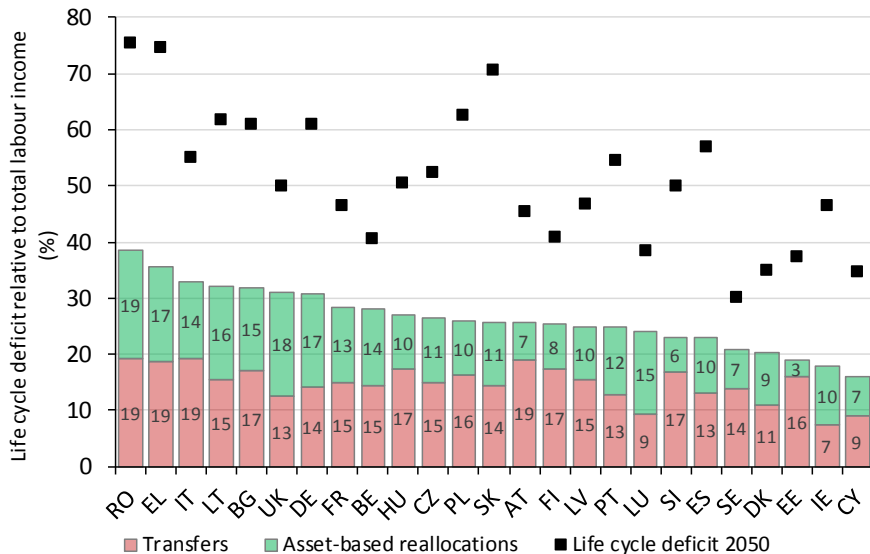
MOTIVATION

- Providing comparable NTA results for all EU countries → at the end 25 because of missing data for Croatia, Malta (aggregate controls) and Netherlands (household budget survey)
- Taking advantage of detailed and synchronized data on the EU level
- Documenting procedures and the data used: The European NTA Manual

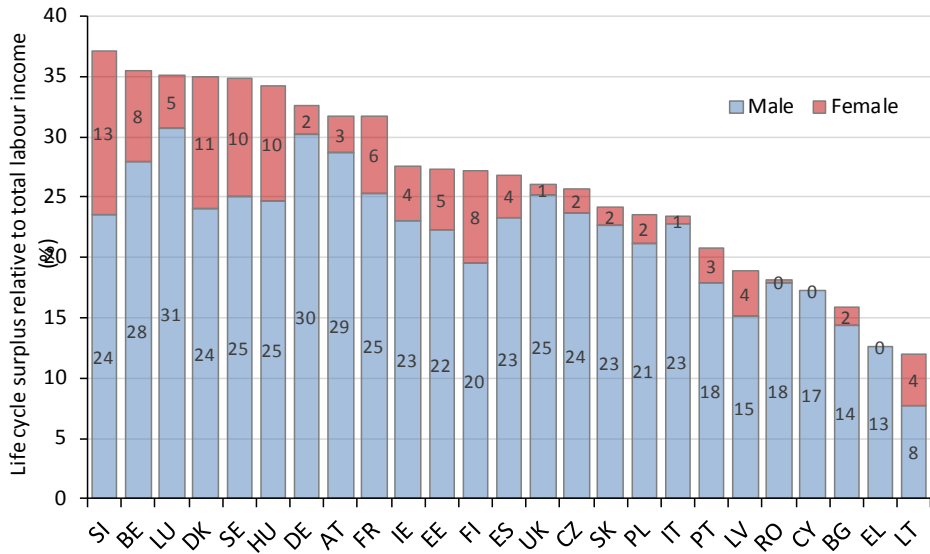
AGE PATTERNS OF CONSUMPTION AND LABOUR INCOME (EU, 2010)
