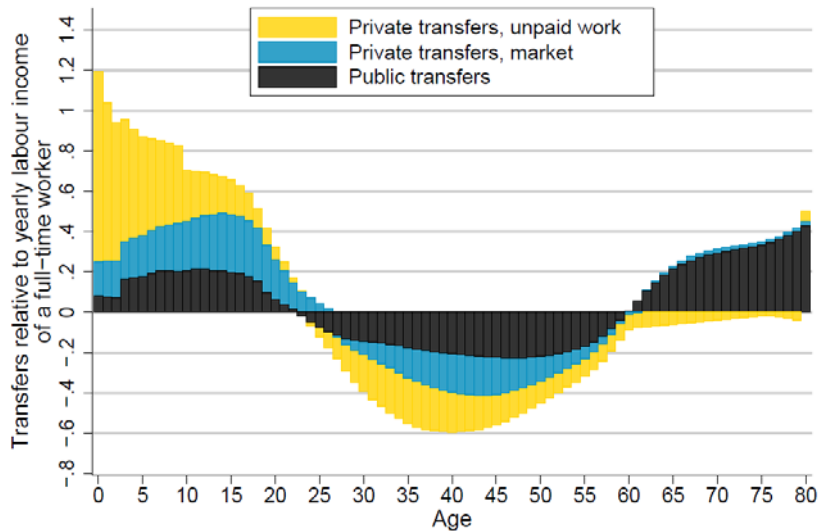


Figure 1: Net transfers in monetary terms by age in 16 European countries

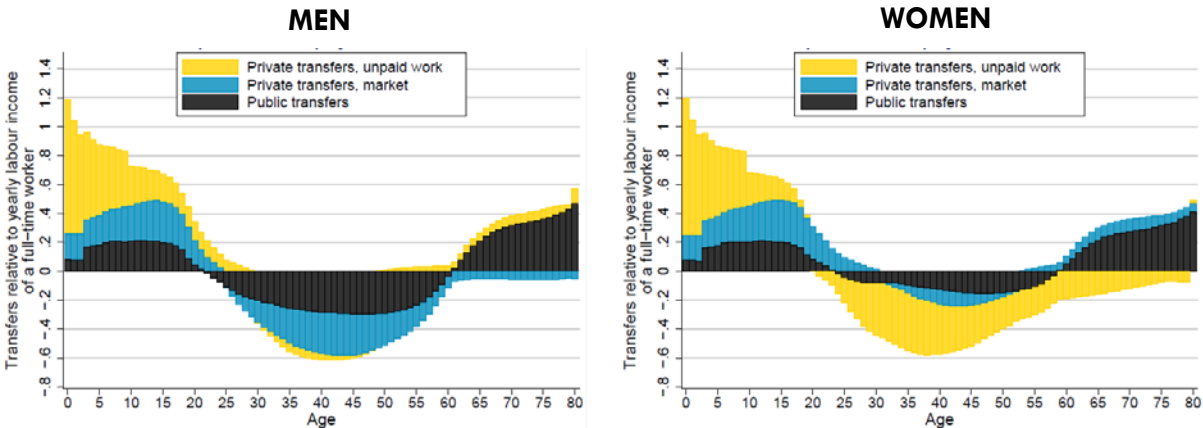


Figure 2: Net transfers in monetary terms by age in 16 European countries

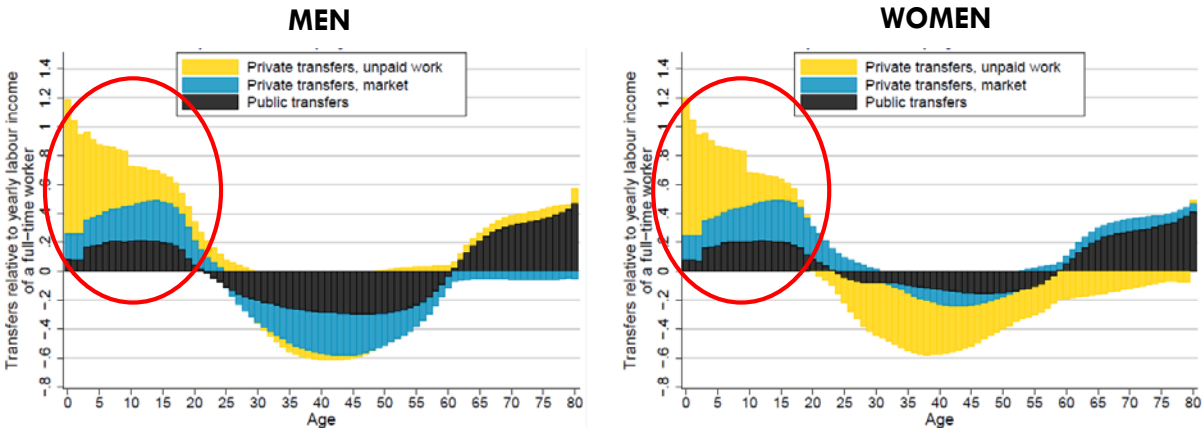


Figure 2: Net transfers in monetary terms by age in 16 European countries

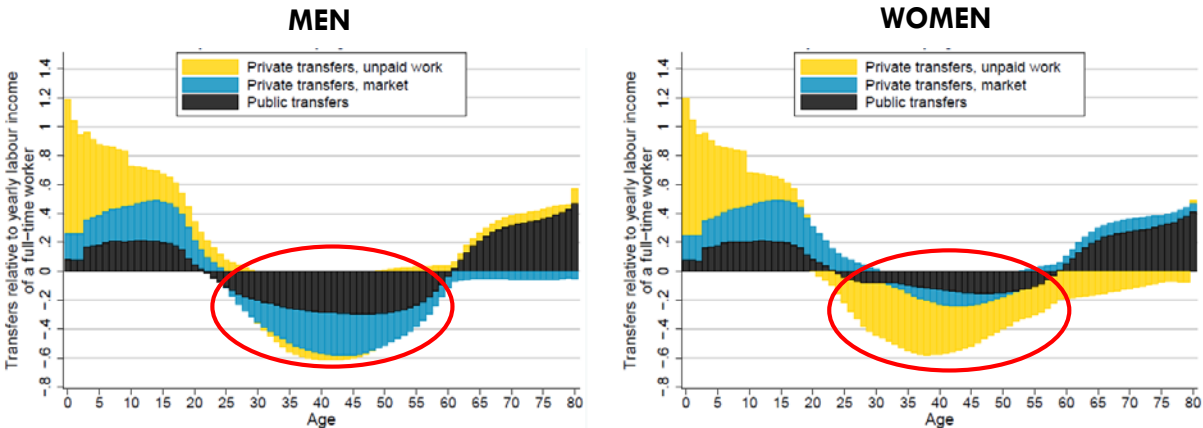
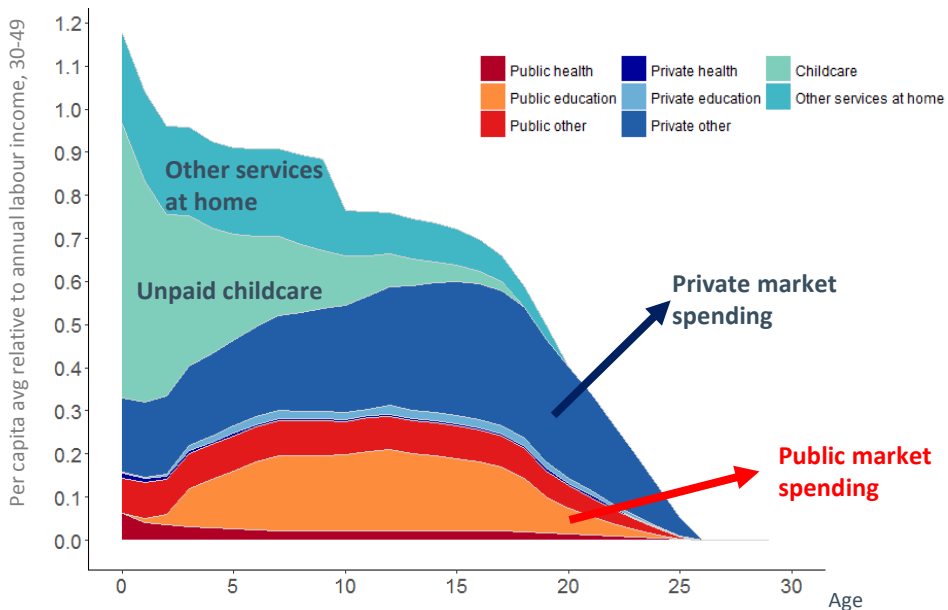


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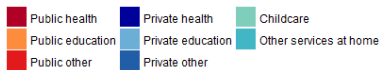
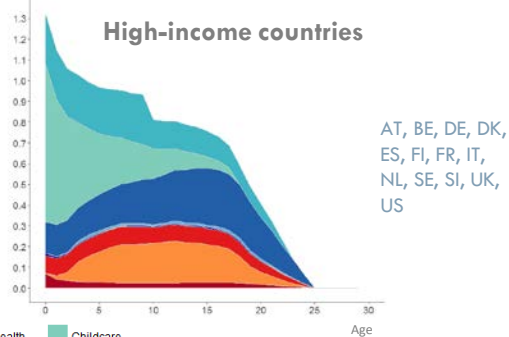
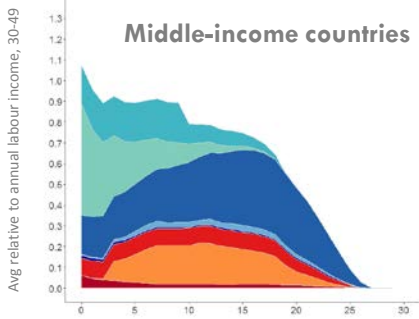
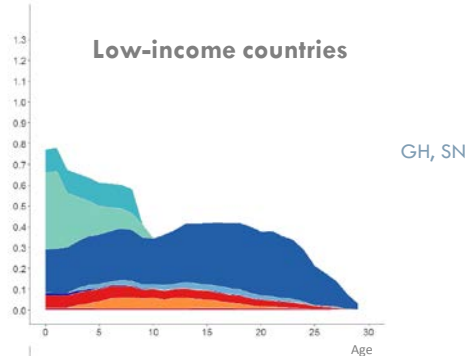
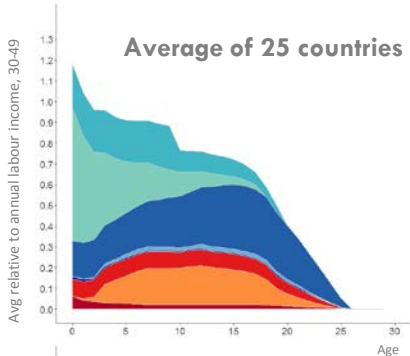

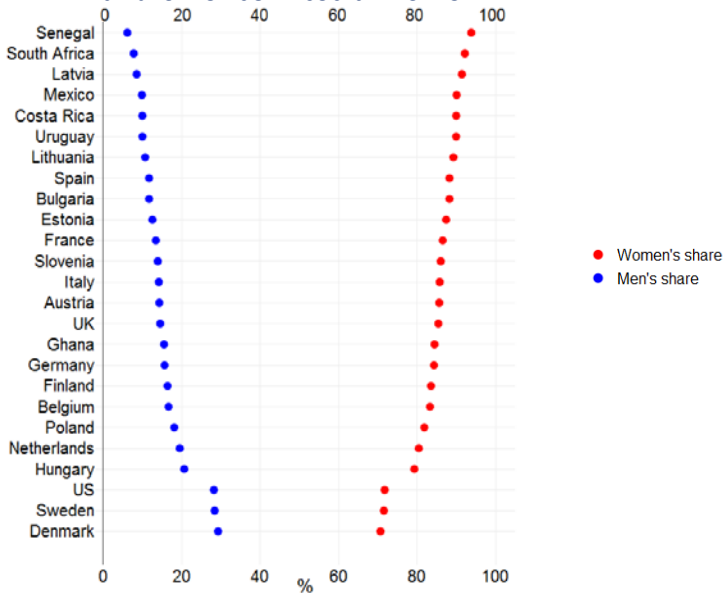


Figure 4: Women's and men's share of providing childcare and other household services in net terms. Source: Vargha, Donehower & Istenic (2017)

The gender gap in making market lifecycle surplus

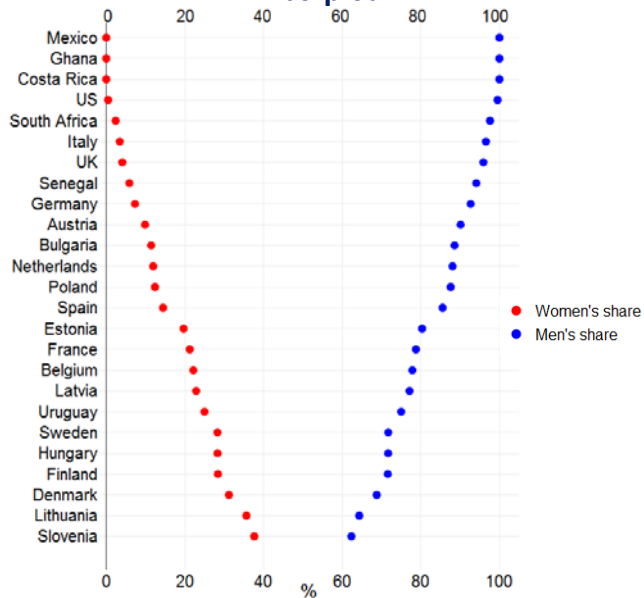
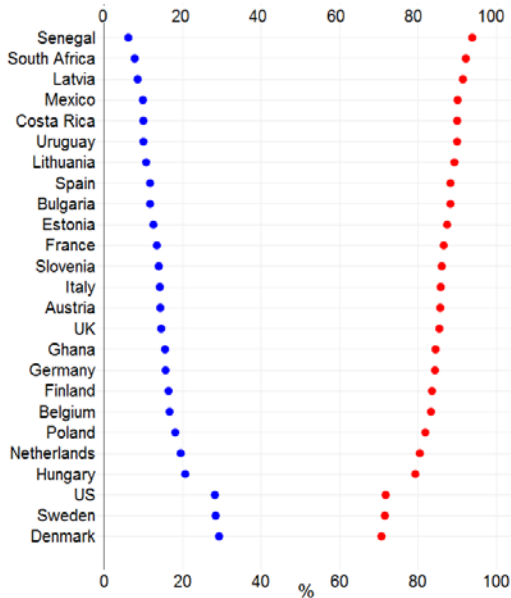


Figure 5: Women's and men's share of providing childcare, other household services and market transfers in net terms. Source: Vargha, Donehower & Istenic (2017)

The gender gap in providing total lifecycle surplus

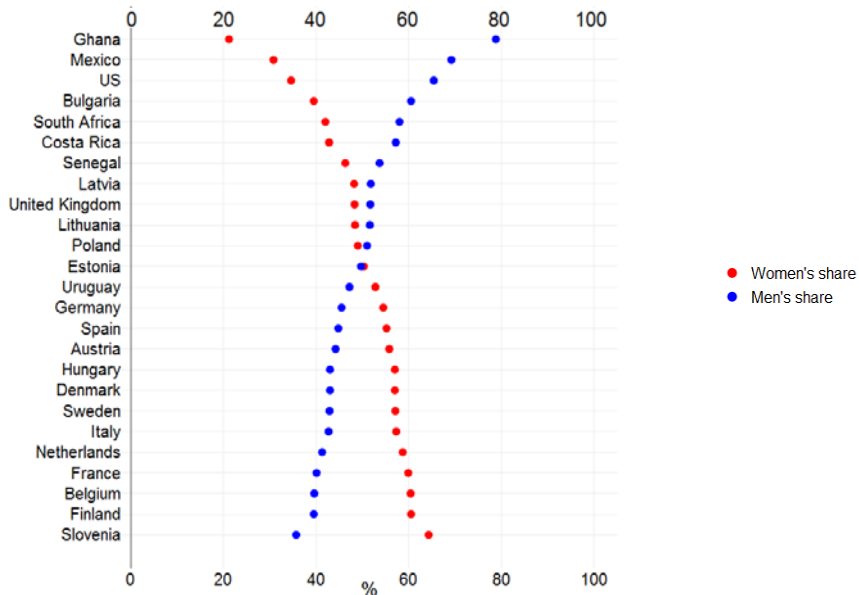


Figure 6: Women's and men's share of providing childcare, other household services and market transfers in net terms. Source: Vargha, Donehower & Istenic (2017)
