2nd Call for Papers – extended deadline 15 June 2013

We are pleased to invite papers for submission for the 8th European Workshop on 'Labour Markets and Demographic Change', 12-13 September 2013, at the Vienna Institute of Demography, Austria.

Topics of Interest

The workshop focuses on economic analysis broadly dealing with the impact of demographic change on labour markets or, indeed, vice versa. We welcome empirical and theoretical contributions from both a micro- and macro-economic perspective. A non-exhaustive list of topics is:

- Age distribution of working age population and supply of/demand for workers
- Contract, careers and job design with an ageing workforce
- Age structure and skills of migrants
- Mobility of an aging workforce and regional labour markets
- Health, productivity and job satisfaction
- Long-term unemployment and employment prospects and earnings of older workers
- Fertility and female labour supply and earnings
- Matching, labor market institutions and demographic change
- Retirement incentives

Authors will be notified about acceptance by 15 July 2013.
