- Completed doctoral study in history with specialization in the early modern period
- German language skills at native language level

- Excellent command of Latin paleography and early modern German language
- Experience in archival research, especially with handwritten early modern sources
- Working experience with TRANSKRIBUS, TEI, and other digital editing tools
- Flexibility, communication skills, creativity, and readiness to work in an international team

We offer the opportunity to participate in an internationally networked research project and develop knowledge and skills in digital humanities and digital data presentation. Early postdocs (completed dissertation no more than three years ago) are preferred.

The annual gross salary is € 54.018,02 according to the collective agreement of the Austrian Academy of Sciences. The position is limited to 6 years. In case of transfer of QhoD to the long-term program of the OeAW, tenure track is possible. The start is scheduled for January 1st, 2024.
